There is always a "so what" factor to all the work we do in and for the church. And like most things, if the foundation is not solid, the house on which it is built, will not be sturdy enough to withstand the stress of storms and the wear and tear of time.

What is the "so what" factor of our church? Why is it important to engage in a level of knowing the worries, contributing to the work, sharing the load?

Sammy and I were in Vancouver, WA last weekend for a dance competition weekend. It was hosted by the Hilton Vancouver, right at the Convention Center and the Esther Short Park. During a break, we walked through the park to Starbucks for a drink and a snack. As we were making our way back, we saw an elderly man, obviously unhoused, sitting on a bench. Sammy looked me and said, "Do you have anything we can

give him?" And I did have a food gift card. Sammy gave it to him, touched his hand and said, "Hi, I hope this helps you." He smiled and thanked her for being so kind.

Homelessness is becoming a polarizing issue. I believe it will take communities and governments working together to truly address it, beyond merely criminalizing it.

What struck me about this encounter was that Sammy saw this elderly man as a human being, made in God's image. And that comes from her time in our church...her baptism into a faith that teaches us to love our neighbors as ourselves.

There are so many stories like this--lives that have been touched by God in Christ through our little community of faith.


Children Worship & Wonder is cancelled for Sunday, May 5th.
